John, You Will Be Missed!

We are sad to hear about the passing of long time club member John Pegg. Here is a member profile from a few years ago on John.

This month's "Member Spotlight" features John Pegg. If you have been to many of our chapter car shows or to meetings north of I-64 you've seen John Pegg and you've seen Timmy, John's grandson now 11 years old who has been coming to our events for years.

John has displayed quite a few Buicks at different local, regional and national shows, with mostly 1966 to 1970 models but I am only familiar with two that he shows now: a '66 Wildcat 2-dr HT, Shadow Turquoise (a Buick special order paint) that has been a National Senior winning car since 1997, and the 1970 Dark Chestnut Electra 225 2-dr HT that he took to the Rochester, Minnesota, National last summer and which was awarded a silver. I'm sure it will go gold next show.

John has several 1966 Buicks, some running and some parts cars and he won't mind being your 1966 Buick technical advisor. John's first new car was a '50 Buick Special that he ordered after returning from the Navy. He worked in the moving business for a short time, but we all know him as a St. Louis County police officer who retired a year ago. Make his acquaintance and you'll find he is a really great guy. But back to cars, John has owned a bunch of Buicks. He listed off years of 1953, 1955, and 1960 as well as a bunch in the 1966 to 1970 model years. John prefers unmodified Buicks, but I'm bugging him to get into the 21st century and broaden his Buick passion.

There is a reason for the missing emblem on the front of the '70 Electra 225. John keeps it in the glove compartment most of the time. (Continued on Page 2)



The emblem is plastic and on the leading edge of the Car and finding a replacement if this one should be stolen or broken would be almost impossible.

The '66 Wildcat and the '70 Electra are driven to shows but can compete with trailer queens. John puts many hours into detailing and is a stickler for the correctness of his Buicks. He has had both cars repainted with care to maintain the original color. He is the second owner of each of these. The fully optioned '70 Electra 225, originally a New Mexico car, has only 67,XXX miles on it. The drive train includes the 4 barrel 455 cubic inch engine and even a limited slip differential.

John bought the 1966 Wildcat (originally owned by a Mallory Buick parts man) in 1992 with about 90,000 miles and he has put another 30,000 plus on it.
